2014 was another great success for our event, and received praise from musicians and audiences alike. For a few reasons, we made the decision to move the event to an earlier time in the year which we hope will now become our permanent spot. This year, we have again kept to the same template whilst adding a few new touches.

We are using the wonderful Medina Theatre for the first time, with two exciting gigs there on the Sunday: a combined ticket can be purchased for both gigs, and to see both Sax Appeal and Back to Basie for £24 is great value. Our experiment of beginning on the Thursday was a success, and we do the same this year with a great latin gig comprising mainly Island-based

A theme of this year is that local musicians feature heavily — the Isle of Wight is well known for a rich musical and artistic heritage, and the Jazz Weekend has helped to encourage that particular art form to emerge once more in recent years.


Tickets are available for individual events only. Due to the small size of some venues, tickets are only available for individual events.

Renowned as one of the most dynamic and creative musicians on the UK scene, Gareth Williams (piano) has played with many top names in jazz on both sides of the Atlantic. He joins forces this afternoon with the legendary Dave Green (double bass) in an intimate, enthralling homage to Bill Evans and Scott LaFaro. Both of these musicians have formidable reputations and to hear them in a duo setting will be a memorable experience.


To commemorate the life of the great Art Blakey twenty five years after his passing saxophonist Jean Toussaint has put together this project.


