Northwood Parish Council ReportMeeting held 5th of March 2019

PCSO Derek Howard, representing Cowes Neighbourhood Policing Team presented a report to the Council. The current priority for the Cowes NPT remained the same, reduce drug misuse within the local area. There will be a meeting of the Police and Community Team on the 8th of March. 8 crimes had been reported during this period, up from 3 last year. Several burglaries have occurred in the area and one or two arrests have been made. The Police are asking all residents to ensure that garages and sheds are locked and any suspicious activity be reported.

Inspection of Parish Assets.

The Clerk advised that the metal pole for the Dog Bin in Cranleigh Gardens has been replaced and the metal seats at Four Cross and Wyatts Lane have been repainted. Samantha Kinnaird, the Environment Officer has been active around the Village, doing regular patrols and talking to people about dog fouling. The Parish Council are paying for a Dog Bin for Pallance Lane.

Town and Country Planning

The Parish Council reiterates its recommendation for refusal of the application for building on land adjacent to 424 Newport Road, as this would result in an unacceptable level of settlement coalescence. The valuable green gap between Newport and Northwood needs to be protected. It was noted that a notification of a change of use of the Horseshoe Inn from a public house to a shop. Councillors felt this should be resisted as the Horseshoe had a thriving clientèle and was located at the heart of the village. The Parish Council are undertaking steps to nominate the Horseshoe Public House as a community asset. Cllr Nicholson advised he would shortly be organising a further Ward walk with Island Roads representatives.

The Vexatious Complaints Policy was approved, subject to one or two minor amendments.

Work on updating the Parish Plan, Community Emergency Plan and the Northwood Business Survey was progressing.

Cllr Nicholson gave his ward report, with particular mention of The Draft Island Planning Strategy Development Plan Review, Poor Policy and Decidophobic Management and the new revised Historic Walk to commemorate the anniversary of the Blitz in Cowes and the valiant action of the Blyskawica on the 5th of May.
