Hello friends.

Of course it is going to come as no surprise what my mind is turning towards as I write this piece... Christmas. Dare I ask how the preparations are going? Yeah I thought so, well we've still got a few weeks so don't worry.

Often when I'm having a conversation about Christmas, I hear people complain about the commercialisation of Christmas. 'It's so expensive nowadays, in my day we were lucky to get...' you get my drift. Well I've been reflecting upon what the commercialisation of Christmas actually means. Questioning, is there a general opinion that people hold about the commercialisation of Christmas? And reflecting upon it, I think there is.

Of course this is only my opinion so do feel free to disagree but I believe that what people are actually saying is that Christmas is just too expensive. It's not the actual spending of money that we object to, it's the amount, it's the pressure that we perceive, that only the biggest present will do. It's as if we believe that we are judged how much we love someone by how much we spend on them. Well I hope that's not the case.

As humans we have a desire to want to do good, we want to buy things that people like, we have an urge to 'do the right thing' whether that means buying a bunch of flowers for someone's funeral or wanting to aid someone when they have fallen down for instance.

Humans are naturally good, I believe and have an instinctive wish to do good. Therefore, is it our lack of self-confidence, our lack of self-worth that makes us feel under pressure to be over indulgent at Christmas I wonder? Do we send out Christmas cards in the hope we get some back and therefore feel loved? Or do we send out cards because we know someone needs to feel loved. Only you know the answer.

At Christmas, at the heart of the Christmas message, God came to us, because of his deep sense of love for us, his creation. God came to show us how to live, how to love and how to serve others. He didn't come to see how much he was loved; he came to show us his love. Sadly, in showing us how to truly live and love he upset a lot of people, people who were using their positions to further their own agenda. But Jesus never deviated from his desire to help others and sadly he gave his life, for us, because of his love for us.

Prescriptions are changing at Cowes Medical Centre

To help us manage the increasing number of prescriptions, all you need to do is let us know which pharmacy you would like your prescription sent to. It is easy to do, simply tell us over the phone, at the front desk, or on a prescription request form. You don't need a computer, we send it electronically to the pharmacy you have

We are also increasing the number of patients on Repeat Dispensing (batch) - this means the GP approves a prescription list once, for up to 12 months' of medication. You then don't need to keep requesting repeat prescriptions, instead you can go to the pharmacy you have selected when your next medication is due. (This will not be suitable for all patients, or all medication, but the majority of patients will be able to use this service).

Benefits from these changes:

- Reduce the queue at the front desk,
- Patients are able to collect their medication from a pharmacy without having to visit their GP to collect a paper prescription
- The Practice and the pharmacy can track the prescription all the way through he process
- GPs spend less time dealing with prescriptions which saves valuable time, and we hope this will result in more appointments for our patients

Despite the lack of planning and poor communications, we now have an undertaking to support the service through its replacement with a more flexible locally derived service, that can be better tuned to fit needs more specifically, without paying the huge costs under the more rigid (but good as a starting model), scheme.

Northwood was one of the first to sign up to this, at the beginning, some four or five years ago, but, without explanation, we have been left out, although we will get represented under the new scheme and might still have a LAC under the old scheme, but with funding secured by Public Health from other sources.

The Pub Co Question

This year the Island has seen unprecedented closing of landmark pubs, the Pier View in Cowes being one. Press stories attribute scandalous rent hikes and extortionate charges for supplies that have to be bought through the Pub Co. Some poor landlords, it seems, loose all their money, as the greater their sales, the higher their rent climbs. Government reviews and legislation have tried to deal with this situation, but to little avail. An analogy is of taking on a mortgage/ rent and having to buy all your groceries from the lending company. Then you find that the provisions are delivered by a supermarket, and you are paying vastly more than your neighbour for exactly the same product from the same supplier. Then, to top that, your mortgage/ rent goes up, and (in some Island cases) could be two or three times the open market rate.

There are those landlords who despite all this seem to do well. These landlords seem to run several pubs and be quite adept and experienced business people. Some publicly state that they went in to their contract with their eyes open, with good business and legal advice.

It seems that the industry is open to exploitation. Our MP has arranged for a representation from Island pubs to go up to Parliament to discuss these issues with the minister. There is a significant and challenging campaign established to raise awareness of the situation and need for decent reform — The Forum of Private Business.

I don't want to isolate or pick on the health service, because other organisations are just as guilty. But, how do we get over this, in a real and effective way?

People and organisations tend to look at the outside world, primarily and instinctively from a defensive point of view, and once you realise this, whether you are a person of an organisation, you have the power, in that realisation, to control what you do; to continue or do it differently. Change, understanding, growth, development, innovation follows on from seeing and doing from different perspectives.

The Local Area Co-Ordinator (LAC) Row

You may have noticed the protests concerning ceasing Local Area Co-Ordinators (LACs). Some of the protesters are health/ care professional and others are people that were against the scheme in the first place but are converted by their experience. What LACs do is not rocket-science, it's good old-fashioned community work, and could be taken up and supported by many other sources, including Town and Parish Councils. Basically, LACs direct people who need help to other services and see it through. It was a model adopted and funded by the Vanguard pilot, but with no exit or continuity strategy. The scheme is operated under strict licence, so is not flexible, and is hugely expensive to operate, costing around $\mathfrak{L}^{1/2}$ million.

Apologies were received from Cllrs Margaret Court and John Ward.

PCSO Steve Anker from Cowes Neighbourhood Policing Team gave a report about crime in Northwood. Although the figures were still low, there were 7 crimes compared to 3 in the same period last year. A member of the public highlighted his concerns about the perception of speeding along Wyatts Lane and dangerous parking in the vicinity of the school. He expressed his interest in taking part in Speedwatch and Steve said he will pass on his details to PCSO Lisa Paul who co-ordinates these events.

Cllr Fuller reported that a number of residents have complained about speeding in Pallance Road and Wyatts Lane, and anti-social parking. The Parish Council have asked for speeding and anti-social parking to be monitored and enforcement taken in those areas. A number of motorist have been ticketed for speeding in Pallance Road and the Parish is seeking more volunteers to join speedwatch.
