Letter for March

Hello there!

This majority of this year's month of March is Lent for Christians around the world.....a traditional time of reflecting, thinking and praying. Some people love this, I will be honest with you, I struggle with it. When I was at theological college, we had quiet days every term: this consisted of silence for the whole day, prayers and sermons and a key speaker giving us reflective addresses to think about throughout the day. These days were planned in each term, we had no decision as to when we 'wanted' to stop and reflect and in all honesty they never came at a good time for me: I was either not in the right frame of mind, stressed out about an essay that was due in imminently, needed companionship....and normally by late afternoon I was one of a small group of people who secretly texted one another and met up outside the college grounds and went for a walk, somewhere for coffee and cake or simply sat in the car listening to the radio!

And do you know what, I continue to struggle with silent, reflective times.....my excuse now is that my life is rather frantic, professionally as a priest of two parishes totally nearly 10000 people and personally with a full time working husband and two young boys (don't worry, be assured I love being busy) and I struggle to sit down and read a book or watch the TV, especially if there is washing to be put on, dishwasher needing to be emptied, rooms hoovered etc. etc. Quite simply it is just not in my character to stop and be, to read and reflect, to pray and to listen. Just as my boys cannot sit still for more than a moment (unless the 'Square Idol' in the corner of the room is switched on), I have always been someone that is continually doing.

But do you know what. I NEED TO STOP. I NEED TO BE. I NEED TO REFLECT. Why? Because otherwise I will continue to be too busy to properly see where I am, be aware of what I have and do not properly appreciate the world around me - in my own life, around our community, on the island, in our world. And I think perhaps I am not the only one.

I recall reading a book about Desmond Tutu, and in it there's a quote from his friend, Francis Cull who talks about Tutu's prayer life revolving around rest, prayer, and work and in that order. Consider this for a moment: Desmond Tutu - He served as archbishop of the Province of Southern Africa, a Christian community including millions of people in several countries. He was a principal leader in the fearsome, demanding struggle to free South Africa from apartheid.

Just like Desmond Tutu, each of us in our unique way must give priority to rest, to stop and 'count your blessings' as the old song goes, to have some deep reflective prayer with God or if you do not believe to reflect on your life, who you are and where you are at the moment and then work – act on the world around you, on your reflections as to who and where you are, work towards what you truly need to do, not just have been doing for months and years.

Don't have a depressive Lent, where all you do is moan about the thing you have given up. Instead rejoice in the things you have and perhaps take up something instead – rest, reflect and/or pray, yes but also act. Be more aware of your life and the world around you through your resting and reflecting so you can be the most productive person you can be: whatever your age and whatever your ability.



Who or What is your church - Part two!

Searching for the Families UNDERWOOD & McCAUL

My g-g-grandfather, Charles Underwood, was born at Norwood around 1809 to Charles Underwood Snr and Margaret Mary McCaul. I am hoping someone somewhere will have knowledge of Charles Snr and Margaret's families and would be willing to share it with their many cousins in Australia.

The only leads we have to Chas Jnr's family from the IW is that he may have left behind a sister by the name of Mary Ann Underwood – a woman with such a name having died there in 1842; and there was perhaps a brother/ uncle/ grandfather with the name Henry.

Charles landed in Sydney from IW in 1833 as a groom, aged 24. After just a few years in Sydney he had tenure over most of what is today, Sydney's world famous Bondi Beach. He is also thought to have introduced the horse-drawn omnibus to Australia, on Boxing Day, 1843.

In the archives of the Isle of Wight Family History Society is a pedigree of a Chas Underwood, born at Norwood around the same era. That Charles is not my g-g-grandfather; nevertheless, it is probable the two were close cousins.



Post Office

The clerk circulated a letter, dated February 1st, from Mr Adrian Skinner, Network Transformation Area Manager of the Post Office Ltd, which Miss Calver had passed to her earlier in the day. This letter set out an alternative approach proposed by Post Office Ltd and appeared to be far more positive in ensuring a long term sustainable Post Office service in Northwood, covering a period of at least 12 months. The situation would then be reviewed as the circumstances of both parties could very easily have changed within that timescale. Island Roads.

Councillors considered the request from Island Roads, as set out in the January/ February edition of their Councillor Update, for details of any roads that could be considered as a priority for inclusion within their carriageway resurfacing programme for 2016/17.

It was agreed that the resurfacing of Oxford Street should be suggested as a priority for inclusion within Island Roads future carriageway resurfacing programme planning.

New water main

Cllr J Nicholson referred to the problems caused by the road closure along part of Newport Road, while the installation of a new 450mm size water main took place. He had been part of the discussions held between Southern Water, Island Roads and IW Council officers. The disruption, due to the necessary, major civil engineering works, could not be speeded up, as access to premises had to be maintained along that stretch of the roadway. He agreed to keep a watchful eye on the situation and provide a further update at the next meeting.

NORTHWOOD PC REPORT FOR MARCH

Police report

Particular mention was made of the following:

Seven crimes had been committed during the month of January, compared to eight crimes committed for the same period in 2015

At the recent PACT meeting three new community priorities had been agreed and these would remain unchanged until mid-April. The priorities being:

- To prevent and detect non-dwelling burglaries in the Cowes, Northwood and Gurnard area;
- Reduce the number of reportable incidents at Cowes Enterprise College;
- To prevent speeding along Mill Hill Road, close to the zebra crossing with Love Lane;
- A recent Speed Watch activity had taken place on Place Road. A total of 141 vehicles had passed through the checkpoint, with 6 cars recorded as having breached the 30mph limit, at 35 mph or above.

Matters arising from the minutes

As previously advised two copies of the revised MOU, together with a list of the Community Partnership's known assets, had been sent to the Secretary of the Community Partnership, in December. Unfortunately, the clerk still awaited a response. Following inquiries, it was now known that the Partnership's January meeting had been cancelled due to several of their members being unwell. The next meeting was scheduled for March 15th . As Cllr Pullen would be unavailable, it was suggested that Cllr Smith be approached to see if he would be free to attend.

Details of the Central Government grant for 2016-17 had recently been received. The amount to be passed over to the Parish Council was £645, which when compared to the current financial year when the sum of £911 was received, showed a decrease of £266.

To note the one-off payment of £5k to be used for the benefit of the residents in Northwood and to consider any appropriate projects.

The clerk advised that she received two copies of the Deed of Offer and the Bribery Act 2001 compliance form, which had all been duly signed by the Chairman. The one-off payment should be received within two months of the date of the Deed being signed by all parties. The Offer had to be used for the benefit of the community. In discussion it was agreed that this could provide
