## HELLO THERE!

I struggled to begin my article this month: in the end my husband asked me 'Well what does **'March'** mean to you?' The way he emphasised the word 'march' suddenly brought a vivid image into my mind – Warrant Officer Scarrett, the Parade Chief at Britannia Royal Naval College Dartmouth, standing in front of us new recruits and telling us, as I am sure he did every new entry, that we were the worst group of misfits he had ever seen and that it would take a small miracle to get up in an shape for our Passing Out ceremony in front of the Queen....and then him shouting MARCH!

I laughed – so 'march' does have some memories for me. Reflecting on this I asked other people what March meant to them – and their answers were very different; a hare, daffodils, my wedding anniversary, spring. I wonder what it means to you as you are reading this? Answers on a postcard to me.....!

And that got me thinking – so what does 'church' mean to you? Does it bring back memories of being dragged to as a child? The magical day when you got married? Somewhere peaceful where you can pray? A place where you found God? A place where you feel welcome or feel a stranger? A cold, dusty building or a beautiful ancient building down the bottom of the lane? Something that has played a part in your life or somewhere that doesn't seem relevant to you?

Church has changed significantly in the last century. For a start the Church of England now lets women like me to be priests and even Bishops, but other faiths have changed too – the Roman Catholic church now has married men as priests and there are new churches that have evolved – Apex church is one in our own town of Cowes. We are truly blessed to have such a variety of Christian churches within our area which offer a huge spectrum of worship and ways of exploring and following God for the local population... the enclosed leaflet gives all the contact details and services of the members of Churches Together In Cowes (CTIC).

But it seems for some reason many people are still wary of church, despite having some faith in God or spirituality. A national survey in 2016 found that 48% of those asked believed in God or a higher spiritual power and yet UK church membership is just over 10% of the population. That is a big difference between these figures. We were blessed to have hundreds of people come into church over the Christmas period with so many people said to me 'I have enjoyed this service so much, church is so different to what it used to be' and

At the other end of complaints, the recipient may take the complaint personally and act defensively, and whilst saying they encourage complaints, in fact do everything they can to put obstacles in the way – from lengthy form filling to tactical questioning. But, in doing this they are missing the one of the best and most honest feedback giving opportunities that they could possibly ask for. I recently heard a comment about a constructive complaint that had quite obvious value to elderly, disabled and infirm, that the recipient said they did not have many complaints on this item, as though to devalue the complaint, but the very type of people that the complaint concerned where the most likely people to not complain because they were in the least fit state to do so. Please complain when someone needs to get feedback on their service or operation, and view it as objective feedback, without being personal. If I might be able to lend support, then let me know; its what I am here for.

#### **Health Service Update**

Our health services are at a point where major internal changes to culture, habitual behaviour and expectations have to happen in order to progress improvements and quality of delivery and service. The scene is set and we have some powerful influences driving this transformation, mainly as a result of the improvements required by the Care Quality Commission (CQC). We still have a way to go and we must now get over this hurdle to disperse the residual effect that has arisen over many years that will stop progress. This has to happen, and if we do not deal with this obstacle ourselves, others will take over and do it less sympathetically for us.

In Scrutiny, we are giving as much support and encouragement to resolving the issues that have beleaguered us, at first criticising, now supporting good practice wherever that is emerging, but also trying to link and example different partners to meld improvements, insights and progress.

This process will cause discomfort and upset but is the metamorphic pain of essential transformation. This Island has the resource and opportunity to shine, but only with the right direction and actions.

### A Good Time to Report Road Drainage Problems

Wet winter weather certainly shows up defects in road drainage, whether it is easily blocked drains or culverts, issues with camber, or leaks from ground water or water services. In some places, like in the upper part of Pallance Road (below Wyatts Lane), seeping water spreads across the road and becomes very hazardous when it starts to freeze. Road salting does not always get it, especially if the salter has to go out round cars.

Are there areas that you know of that need attention, do report it to Island Roads (online or by phone) and, if you can, let me know that you have done so, what and where the problem is, so I can follow it up.

### Anti-Social or Inconsiderate Neighbours

I have had a few people reporting inconsiderate, ant-social, even hostile behaviour visited on peaceful Northwood residents by some neighbours recently. Northwood is not like that, normally, people move here because it is a neighbourly place, and residents should not and must not put up with ant-social behaviour, whatever the circumstances or problems that these offenders may have.

If you are experiencing any such problems, please report to the police and social services. If a housing association owns the house, report to them too, and, please let me know so that I can back you up and follow the complaint through if needed.

### Seeing and Using Complaints as Valuable Constructive Feedback

We hear that the British do not complain enough, unlike some of our continental cousins, and, it may be true. Many people don't want to be labelled a complainer and may also be frightened that they will be singled out and suffer repercussive consequence. Others just can't be bothered with the effort or might not like to risk aggressive or defensive response.

## Northwood Parish Council Report 5<sup>th</sup> February 2019

There was no representative of Cowes Local Safety Neighbourhood Team present but in the February Newsletter received prior to the meeting, the Teams current priority is to reduce drugs misuse within the local area. This includes the utilising of their powers to tackle those producing and dealing with controlled substances. The priorities would be considered again at the next PACT meeting on the 8<sup>th</sup> of March.

### Inspection of Parish Assets.

The Clerk advised that the two benches in Nodes Road, adjacent to the Four Cross Bus stop had been cleaned and repainted. Work programmed include the Dog Bin in Cranleigh Gardens, and the two metal seats at Four Cross.

### Town and Country Planning

Mr Chris HOUGHAM is assisting Councillors in the consideration of and response to the draft Island Planning Strategy Development Plan with particular focus on the implications for Northwood. The Strategy Plan has highlighted the potential for an extra 391 properties to be built in Northwood. This would increase the property count from 1,028 to 1,319, an increase of 38%. Reference was made to the attempt by our local MP Bob Seeley to reduce the target of 641 homes per year on the Island to a more realistic number of 300. The Northwood Planning Committee will discuss this at the next planning meeting on the 19<sup>th</sup> of February. The Parish Council raised no material objection to the following planning applications.

42 Venner Avenue, 34 Greenways and supported the application at Honimax Stables, subject to conditions that the self contained holiday accommodation is used for tourism purposes only. Work on the updated draft Parish Plan and Community Emergency Plan is proceeding.

### Funding requests.

It was decided to give the sum of £50 to the IW Armed Forces Day 2019 event in Newport on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of June.

Cllr Nicholson reported that a new Defibrillator has been installed at the Travellers Joy, adding to the ones at the Community Hall, Northwood Primary School, Strainstall and Bodywise at Somerton.
