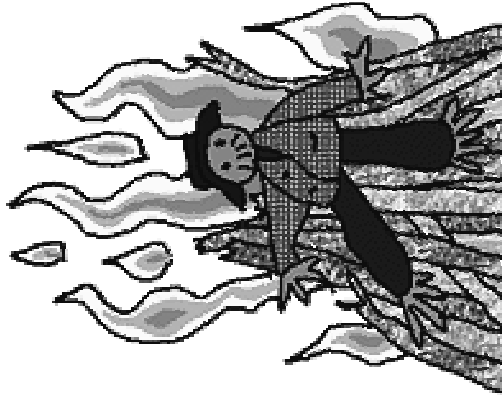

November letter

Hello there!

'Remember, remember the fifth of November' is how the poem goes. And even putting the anti-parliamentarian Guy Fawkes to one side, November for the church it certainly is a month of remembering.

The first of the month we have All Saints Day. From its earliest days, the Church has recognised the faithful heroes whose lives have excited others to holiness and have linked the Church on earth and the Church in heaven. Celebrating the feast of All Saints began in the fourth century and it has stuck for 1200 years since: it is a special day for me as both my parishes come together in one church to remember and thank God for all the Saints.

And then the following Sunday the whole country stops to remember those who have fallen in war. Remembrance Sunday is a poignant day for so many people, even those who have never experienced war, as we remember the millions of people who have given their lives in conflicts past and present so we can continue our present life in safety and freedom. Both my parishes will be commemorating the fallen with a special service and for those people who are unable to leave their homes, for one reason or another, there is the national ceremony at the Cenotaph in London. The ceremony has been televised each year by the BBC since 1946. It is the joint-longest-running live televised annual event in the world, the record being shared with the Chelsea Flower Show.

Finally at the end of the month we start our journey towards Christmas with Advent Sunday. Advent Sunday is the fourth Sunday before Christmas Day. This is equivalent to the Sunday nearest to St. Andrew's Day, and falls this year on 29 November. Advent is a season of expectation and preparation, as the Church prepares to celebrate the coming of Christ as a baby born in a stable but also looks ahead to his final advent when he returns at the end of time. Whilst the world is running around in pre-Christmas fun, frantic shopping, excitement and cheer, we in the church are asked to stop, think and reflect – yes trust me it is a very challenging time for me, having to juggle 'reflection' with carol services, nativity plays and two very excited boys!

November is truly a month when we, in the church, are asked not to worry or think about ourselves, but to think of others, past and present, who have had a life of service: from foot soldiers to our Saviour Jesus Christ. We have to be honest – in the busyness of daily life, we sometimes do forget people around us, and just worry about our lives and what is going right/wrong

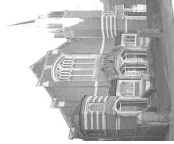

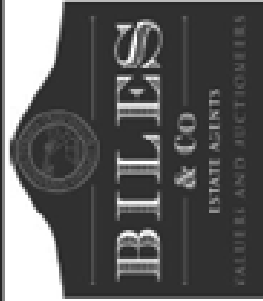

Ward Report –October 2015

With lots happening on the roads programme and in the reforming of Public Health, tied in with Wellbeing, Education and Policing, we are at a very interesting time, and Northwood is certainly playing its part.

Roads

Following concern raised in my last report, I met to discuss local issues with Island Roads, and am assured that greater control of operations is being enacted and that professional investigation is being undertaken and remedy sought regarding the cracking and distortion of some newly laid road surfaces. I, and many others, await this report and these findings, as there are those that remain convinced that the root of the problem, in some cases, lies in the absence of proper foundations, and the remedy is no less than to provide proper foundations. The contract requires that these roads are delivered to good standard and the responsibility lies with the contractor, and, I am assured they are being held to account and standards of delivery will be upheld.

In fact, in the round, the PFI is greatly improving the Island's road network, even allowing for the highlighted faults and failures. Nodes Road is great, and the flooding that beleaguered the lower end of Pallance Road, where the drains were renewed, is totally resolved. There are other good examples too, and we shouldn't forget the decades of patch repair, with comparatively low quality finish, that we endured before.

Something rather more concerning, however, remains after my talk with Island Roads, and that is the apparent lack of control over the Utility Services, who, from reported incidents, seem to be flouting rules of requirement for forward planning, giving notice, and standards of reinstatement, and this malpractice seems so widespread that no one is able to get to grips with what is happening and bring it under control. If this is true, then the Utility Services are wantonly ruining new surfaces in a cavalier manner, without care or respect for the investment, road users and other authorities; unbelievable and unacceptable - anarchy reigns!

Health & Wellbeing

In September, I travelled to meet Professor Steve Peters, of Chimp Mind Management, with our Director of Public Health, Professor Rida Elkheir, to discuss the potential of Professor Peters' programme linking up with the Isle of Wight as an integrated whole. The reception we were given was good, and our visit, which included discussions with Professor Peters

NORTHWOOD PC REPORT OCTOBER

POLICE REPORT

PCSO Derek Howard presented the report of the Local Safety Neighbourhood (LSN) team on matters arising since the last meeting. Particular mention was made of the following: A list of the current team was provided, which was now at full strength; The crime statistics showed that 15 crimes had occurred during the month of September, compared to 4 crimes for the same period in 2014. The clerk queried these figures, circulating a list taken from the "Crime Reports" web site indicating that 7 crimes had occurred in Northwood over the past 30 days. PCSO Howard advised that the discrepancy in the numbers was due to his figures detailing the crimes committed in the IW Council Northwood and Cowes South ward. Councillors requested for the crime statistics to refer to the parish of Northwood only, in future;

The three Community Priorities set by police and local agencies in July were noted. These would be re-considered again towards the end of October; Two Speed Watch events had taken place –1 October, in Pallance Road. 171 vehicles had passed through during a 90 minute period recording only 1 vehicle breaching the limit. And 2 October, in Place Road. 420 vehicles had passed through during a 65 minute period with no recorded breaches of the speed limit. A Speed Watch co-ordinator for the Cowes area was required and further volunteers would be very welcome; Hampshire Alert – a free web based system enabling members of the public to receive police related information by various forms of media

SPEEDING NODES ROAD

Mr T Percival a local resident was in attendance and addressed the Parish Council with regard to his concerns over perceived speeding along Nodes Road/Place Road. Photographs picturing two accidents that had occurred at the Four Cross junction were circulated for information.

PCSO Howard advised that there was no record of any complaints of speeding in this vicinity having been received by the police. Only one accident had been recorded during the last five years, which in his view, suggested that there was no major problem at this junction. PCSO Howard volunteered to set up a Speed Watch event along Nodes Road/Place Road and invited Mr Percival to take part. Cllr J Nicholson also agreed to request the IW Council's Highways safety officer to consider the re-positioning of the speed limit signs in this area and would report back to the November meeting.

JOINT MEETING, COWES, GURNARD, NORTHWOOD

The chairman advised that the initial part of the meeting had focussed on the current Grounds Maintenance and Beach Cleaning contracts. The representatives had suggested that in the future best value might be better achieved by combined working. It had therefore been agreed to take a proactive stance by seeking quotations, to include those areas pertinent to the three councils, which could achieve economies of scale for 2016/17. Details of the current grass cutting regime for the Venner Avenue play area had been forwarded to the clerk for Cowes Town Council, to assist in this process. Additionally it had been agreed to invite Island Roads to take part in a joint meeting to discuss a number of perceived problems in the Island Roads contract in the Cowes local area. This had been organised to take place on 28 October at St Christopher House, Newport.

VENNER AVENUE FOOTBALL PITCH

The clerk advised that due to an error in the calculation of the Parish Council's contribution towards the Parks Service at the Venner Avenue play park, Mr Lee Matthews, the Recreation and Public Spaces Manager had confirmed that the IW Council would not re-charge the costs of re-instating the football pitch area. The work to re-seed the area and move the goal posts would in all probability take place in the early Spring.

WINTER PLANTING

As the tubs and planters continued to provide such a lovely display, Cllr Pullen spoke of his reluctance to remove the plants, at this present time. However, quotations were being obtained for the winter planting, which would need to be ordered prior to the next meeting. It was decided that a maximum spend of £300 on the winter planting be approved.
